RULES BOOK

GENERAL RULES EVENTS

- Each participant should carry identity proof.
- Reporting time for all the participants is 09:00 am.
- > Students taking part in the events should register on the day of the fest at the registration committee. On spot entry is not obliged.
- > Students should refrain from abusive language, obscene display and revealing costumes during the competitions, failing which they will be disqualified.
- > Smoking, drinking and consumption of any such 'substances' are prohibited.
- ➤ The judges' decision is final.
- > Participants should go through the event rules and adhere to the specifics.
- ➤ Participation, props, music etc for certain events should be confirmed Preregistration if required by contacting the event head.
- A participant can participate only in one event during the simultaneous timings for events; a participant is not restricted to participation in any number of events as long as the event timings do not clash.
- ➤ All the events will commence at the scheduled time; Punctuality will be appreciated.
- ➤ Rules are subject to changes at the discretion of the Management/Organizers.
- Criteria for Overall championship include participation in maximum number of events as well as the total scores obtained in the competitions.
- ➤ Participants shall be responsible for their belongings. GGI will not be responsible for any theft or loss of their belongings.

NON-TECHNICAL EVENTS

Winner & Runners-up to get trophies & certificates along with exciting cash prizes.

FACE PAINTING

Prizes: Winner & Runner-up will get Trophies and Certificates

- Team of two participants.
- Theme will be given on the spot.
- Time limit 1 hour.
- Offensive face painting will be disqualified.
- Registration fee for event is Rs.20.

DUMB CHARADES

- Team of 2 Participants
- One team member will pick a chit.
- The other team member has to guess in accordance with the actions performed by his partner in 2 minutes.
- There will be two rounds.
- The team which will take lesser time in guessing the correct answer will qualify for the next round.
- Cheating will lead to disqualification
- No speaking/lip-sync allowed.
- Registration fee of event is Rs.20



THEME PHOTOGRAPHY

Prizes: Winner & Runner-up will get Trophies and Certificates

- Individual participation
- Time limit: 30 min
- Students should bring their own cameras.
- Theme to be given on the spot.
- The photo can be clicked by cameras or mobile phones (Limit 20 Mega Pixel); one of dimension (length/breadth) must be of at least 1600px.
- The photo should be taken within the college campus itself, there will be three rounds.
- Participants will be disqualified in case if submitted picture is edited or copied.
- Registration Fee Rs 20/- per entry
- Winner and Runner-up will get Certificate and Trophies.

MEHNDI

- Team of two participants.
- Time limit 1 hour.
- Mehndi design books or hard copies of designs are strictly not allowed.
- Mehndi cones should be brought by the contestants on their own.
- Registration Fees Rs.20



PATH FINDER

Prizes: Winner & Runner-up will get Trophies and Certificates

- Team of one participant.
- Registration Fee is Rs.20 per Participant.
- Time limit: 10 min
- Manipulation of the car is not permitted
- Robot should be completely autonomous with respect to its power source, Components and Control
- If the robot enters into a loop or goes around the loop more than twice, or if it exits the loop in the incorrect direction, it will be eliminated
- Robots will be eliminated if they do not move after a period of more than 10 seconds.
- The width of path will be 10 to 15 cm.
- Each robot, when placed in its starting position, without any elements unfolded, should not exceeded the size of 20cm (width) x 25cm (length). The path may contain circular curves with any degree of curvature

<u>ON THE SPOT PAINTING</u>

- Rs. 20 is registration fee for the event.
- Theme will be given on the spot.
- Each Participant can submit only 1 poster.
- Timing: 2 hour.
- At the backside of the poster, participant has to mention UID.
- Can use pencil, crayons, sketch, water color, etc.
- Participants have to bring their own colors.
- The poster will be judged on the basis of creativity, message, presentation, neatness and overall effect.
- Violations to any of the above-mentioned rules will lead to the disqualification of the contestants.
- Judge's decision will be final and should be accepted by all.



PAPER DANCE

Prizes: Winner & Runner-up will get Trophies and Certificates

- Team of 2 Participants.
- The team that manages to survive the dancing as last pair wins the game.
- Any pair touching the floor will be disqualified.
- Registration fee is Rs 20 per Team.

NAIL ART

Prizes: Winner & Runner-up will get Trophies and Certificates

- Team of 2 Participants.
- Completion Time: 1hour.
- No previous work should be done on nails.
- Copying of art will lead to fine and elimination.
- Participants should carry their own material.
- Registration Fees Rs.20

TATTOO MAKING

- Team of 2 Participants
- Time Limit: 20 Minutes
- Registration Fees: Rs.20
- Colors To Be Provided On The Spot
- Tatoo Should Be Below Elbow



ROADIES

Prizes: Winner & Runner-up will get Trophies and Certificates

1st ROUND Task: Color Separation

- -An individual will be required to separate buttons of different colours.
- -Time Limit: 30 Seconds
- -An individual who scores maximum will move to the next round.

2nd ROUND Task: Coin Minting

- -In this task, you have to collect as many coins as you can within a particular time limit.
- -If other than mentioned coins are collected, you will be disqualified.
- -The time limit will be decided on the spot.
- -No help from friends.

3rd ROUND Ring the Object

-An individual will have 6 attempts to ring the object. One who scores maximum will be the winner.
